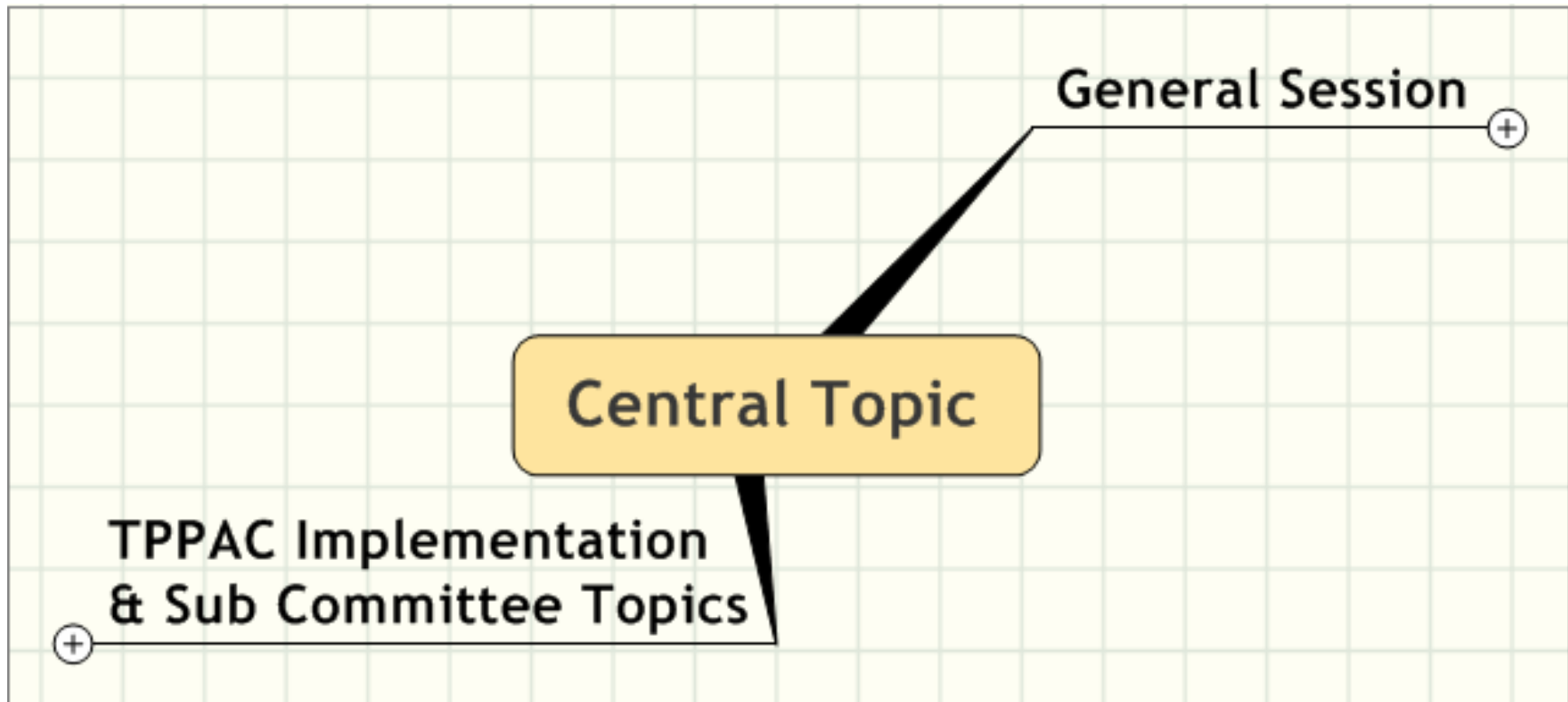


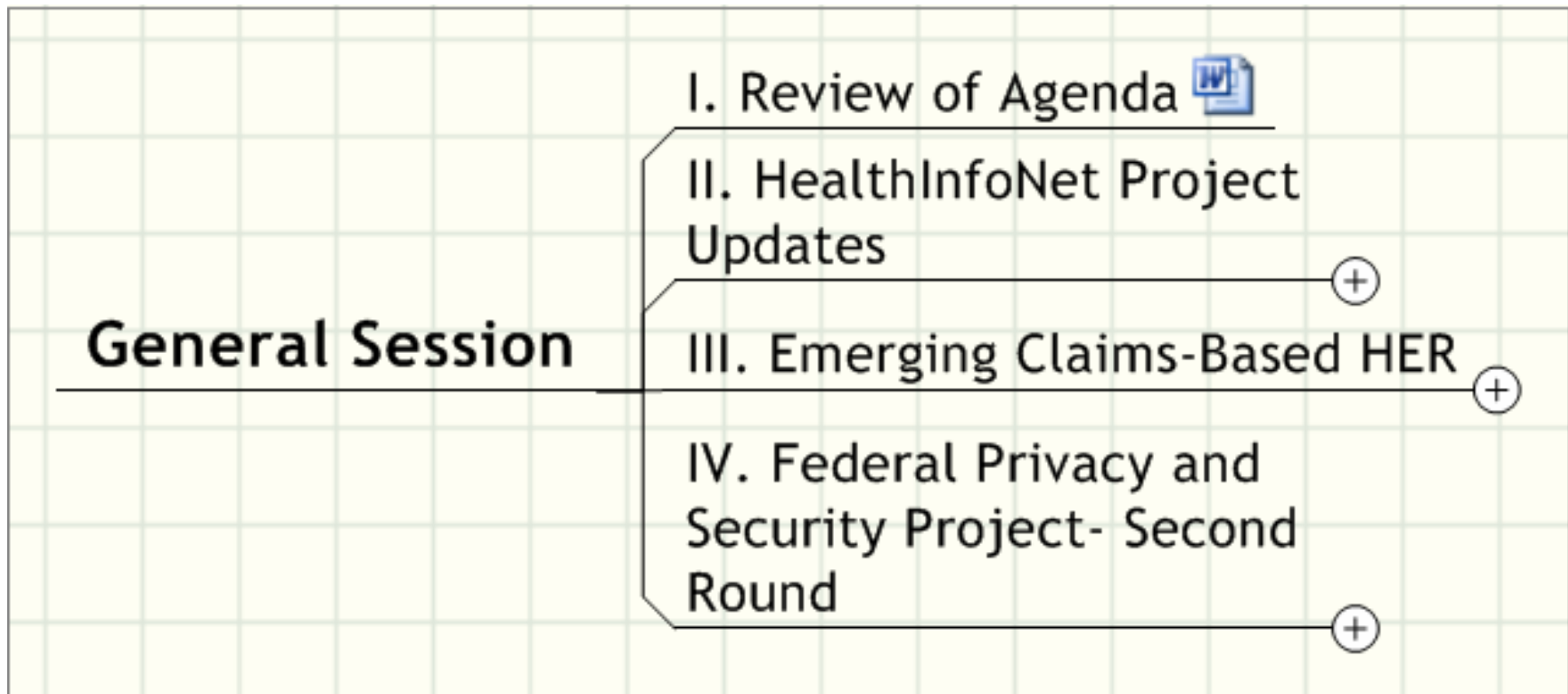

- Funding Update
 - State of Maine Biennial Budget
 - decision on HIN funding request will be addressed within Appropriations Committee over the next two weeks.
 - this is going to be a very difficult negotiation process
 - ONC Grant
 - Request for grant proposal will be issued next week (according to Karen Bell)
 - total dollars and duration of grant awards not public yet
 - CMS Grant Round 2
 - grant criteria have been published as of 4-27-07
 - \$51 million left in pool to be spread over two years
 - grant proposals are due June 15, 2007
 - dollars are to be awarded by no later than 9/30/07
 - Biosense Grant
 - RFP to be issued within days
 - focus of grant is on delivering Biosense surveillance objectives via health information exchange organizations
 - five year award
 - Foundation Applications
 - Brain Foundation
 - Private Donation

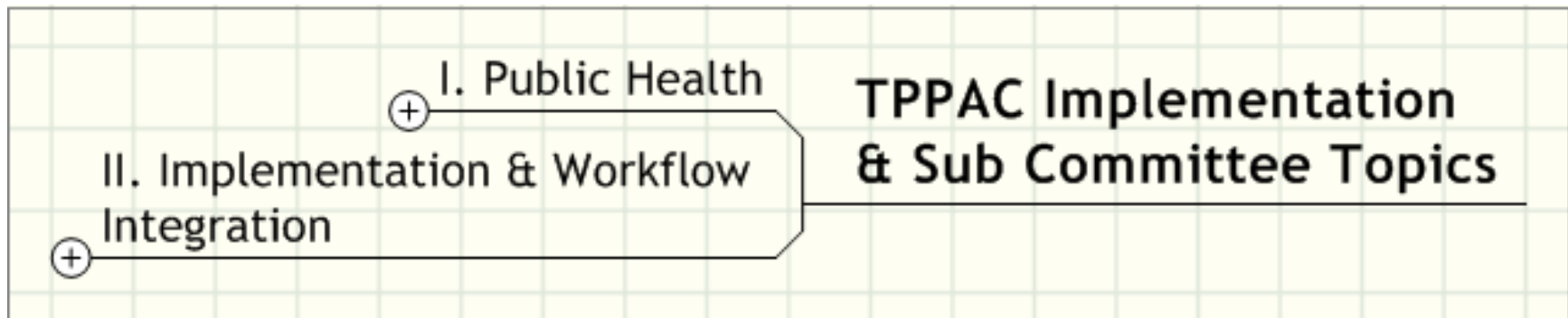

 - \$13,000
 - help fund the development of a proposal for round 2 funds
 - non-competitive grant application
- Discussion of Second Round Grant Objectives and Their Impact on HIN Project Next Steps in Moving from Discovery to Policy
 - six month funding
 - focus on demonstrating implementation of changes highlighted in discovery and evaluation phase of grant
 - key role/opportunity for HIN TPPAC and CAC to use someone else's money to do the work we need to do
 - will heavily leverage security and access capabilities of Orion portal
 - may seek up to \$500 K for this phase that can be applied to 3M implementation
