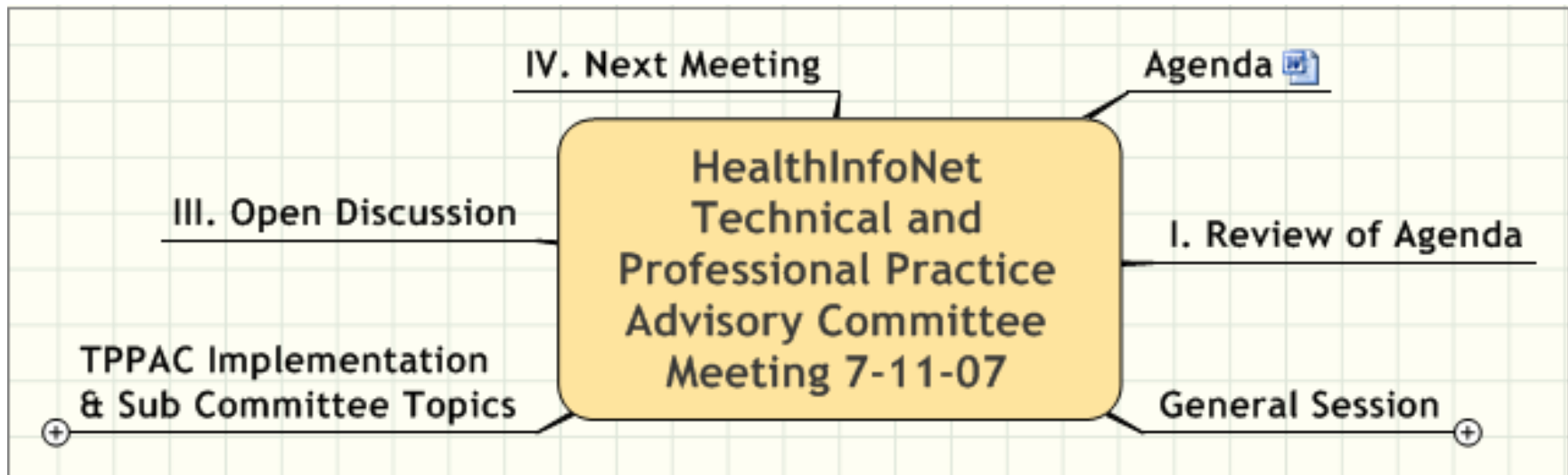
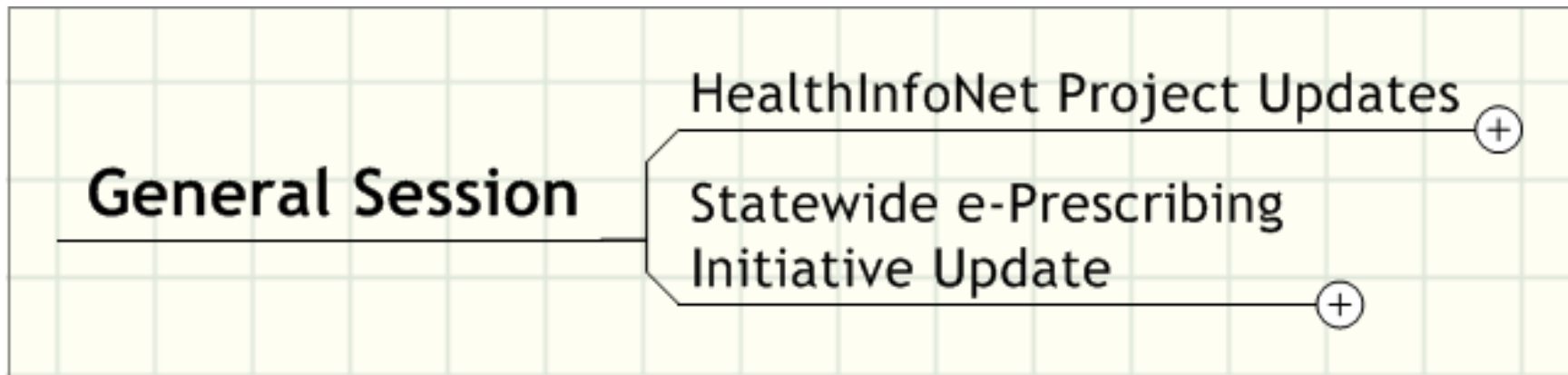

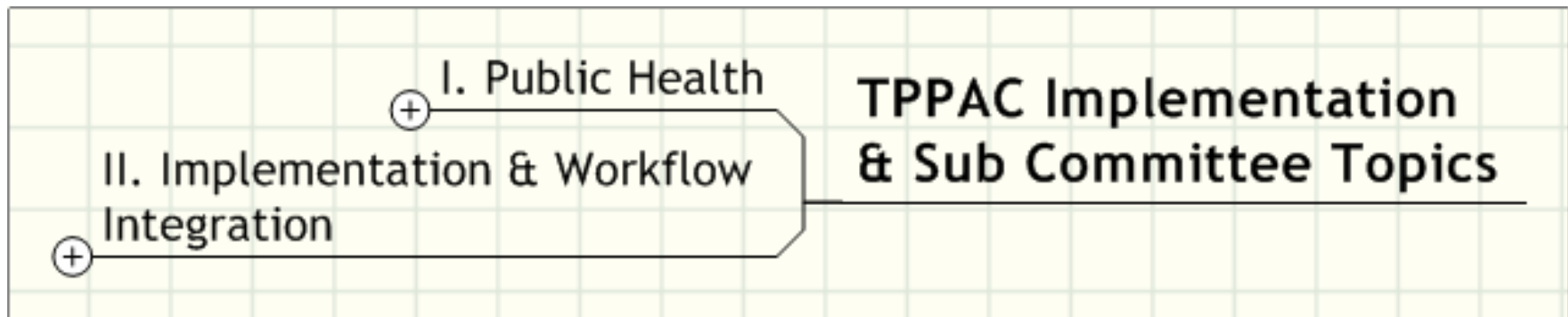
HealthInfoNet Project Updates

 - Cleaning up the participants agreement

 - 3M has proposed a modified business arrangement that is focused on allowing HIN to start the production implementation as soon as possible by breaking the two year initiative in to four phases with the option to walk away at the end of phase I (seven months) and at the end of each subsequent phase

Statewide e-Prescribing Initiative Update

- Steps to Define a Standards-Based Electronic Formulary for MaineCare
 - Work Group of e-prescribing vendors (Allscripts & DrFirst) have convened with representatives from State of Maine to address development of a standards based approach to publishing the MaineCare formulary for use with e-prescribing
 - Three meetings held so far
 - NCPDP V1.0 has been proposed as standard for adoption
 - Vendors have provided examples of their current approaches to formulary format to GHS to help GHS define technical pathway to an electronic formulary standard based on NCPDP V1.0
 - Waiting for GHS to develop specification document
 - Work would be funded out of CMS Transformation Grant monies
- Steps to address Electronic Access to MaineCare Eligibility
 - Working with current subcontractor to State of Maine who is publishing MaineCare enrollment to identify options for re-purposing content in a format that will meet the needs of e-prescribing vendors
